

Annual Fee information for currently accredited programs


NAEYC Accreditation is awarded for a five-year term, ending on a program's expiration date (referred to as the Valid Until Date). All programs are required to pay annual fees as part of maintaining their active accreditation status.

What annual fees am I required to pay?

Accredited programs are required to pay an Annual Accreditation Fee **at the end** of each year to maintain their accreditation. A program's fifth Annual Accreditation Fee is due on or before its Valid Until Date in order to complete the five-year accreditation term. Annual fees are based on the number of children enrolled in the program.

Are there fees for pursuing the renewal process?

Programs that have successfully maintained accreditation and have met all submission deadlines **do not** pay any additional fees to pursue renewal. However, additional renewal fees **will apply** in the event of missed submission deadlines or lapsed accreditation.
